

## Facilities

The Council Circle, recently rebuilt by the Kanawha County 4-H Leaders



Association, is a great place for a campfire program, or outdoor classroom. Wide bench seating and spacious walkways can easily accommodate large groups of over 250.

Horse Barns and riding ring are available for use by equestrian programs or horse shows.



There are four barns with 102 stalls, a wash area, and concession stand.

A Picnic Pavilion is available for camps, clubs, and family reunions throughout the year. Restrooms are available at



the shelter, which seats 75-100. Our kitchen staff will be glad to cater your event!



## Directions

Located approximately 30 minutes from Downtown Charleston, Camp Virgil Tate is easy to find:

### From I-77:

Take the Tupper's Creek Exit (approximately 6 miles north of I-77 and I-79 interchange) to Rt. 21. North on Rt. 21 approximately 1 mile to Sissonville High School, then turn left on Rt. 622 and go 4 miles. Turn right across bridge and go 1-1/2 miles to Camp Virgil Tate.

### From I-64:

Take the Cross Lanes Exit (approximately 10 miles west of Charleston) and go north on Rt. 622. Proceed straight through the traffic signal in Cross Lanes (Rt. 622). Go 3 miles past the traffic light, then turn left when Rt. 622 turns left. Go approximately 4 miles and watch for sign indicating a left turn across bridge. Cross bridge and go 1-1/2 miles to Camp Virgil Tate.

## Welcome!

Camp Virgil Tate is located on over 400 beautiful acres just 30 minutes from Downtown Charleston, WV.

Home to Kanawha County's 4-H camp, for 50 years, Camp Tate is open year-round for meetings, retreats, and camps for all ages! The camp features four cottages, a motel-style lodge, dining hall, picnic pavilion, and several meeting rooms.

Recreational opportunities abound in the large, flat field— or go exploring on one of many hiking and nature trails.

Two Basketball Courts, a volleyball court, and softball field are available for sports enthusiasts.

Relax while fishing in the pond or take a swim in the "Sleepy Glenn" pool.



## Lodging

### **Dormitory style cottages**

Each cottage can sleep between 64 and 68. A small meeting room is located in the front of the cottage. Each side has one small and one large bathroom.



### **Ross Bonar Cottage**

This unique cottage is divided into ten rooms that sleep a total of 68. The bunk beds are removed during the winter months and replaced with 34 single beds for adult groups. A



large meeting room is available in the front of the cottage.

### **"Boone" Maxwell Lodge**

Sleep in air-conditioned comfort in our motel-style lodge.

Each room has double beds and individual baths. Two 70' x 48' meeting rooms with seating for 200 and a small kitchen are located below the sleeping rooms on the ground level.



## Meals

The Dining Hall serves cafeteria-style meals for groups as small as 20 or as large as 300.

Breakfast, Lunch, and Supper can be served each day during camps, or our cooks can prepare a continental breakfast, snack, or banquet for meetings and special events.



Meals can also be catered to one of the conference rooms in the Lodge, for your convenience.

Several menu options, including a salad bar, are available. Please let us know if your group has special dietary needs so that we can accommodate them.

Adjacent to the seating area in the dining hall is a meeting room, which can be separated by a divider curtain. It's an ideal space for a medium-sized gathering!
